Rationale

The Year 12 cohort are the Highview School leaders. One of the ways the School acknowledges this, is through the tradition of graduation jerseys which reflect this achievement.

Aims

- To encourage Year 12 students to understand they are part of a team and not alone through Year 12
- To promote school pride
- To identify Seniors on special days

Implementation

Jerseys are a casual item of uniform and not generally worn to School or to School functions.

However, there are times when Seniors are welcome to wear them. These occasions include: Year 12 Orientation days, Free Dress days, sports days, Camps, during exam practice, on exam days and when agreed with the Head of Senior School.

The following steps are to be followed

In order for these design items to arrive in time for the Year 12 Orientation at the end of Year 11, orders need to be finalised by the start of September. This will be facilitated by the Head of Senior School. The student's Last Name (as it appears on their birth certificate) will be displayed on the back of the jersey.

Students will:

1. Vote for the design each student likes best (there will be three options)
2. Try on samples and advise Reception staff of their jersey size
3. Fill in the order form
4. Pay in full at Reception
